CFCAB strives to maintain equity and diversity on its board, and to represent the communities and regions throughout Central Alberta.



BOARD DUTIES

Board members are expected to:

- meet six times a year as a Board in addition to standing committee meetings
- fulfill time commitment of maximum of seven hours per month
- attend additional meetings as required


TIMELINE
